 As a group of residents we are concerned about plans to remove the stream which may casue flooding and will have reproussions for climate change, biodiversity and conservation issues

the original plans were given permission in 2005 without any regard to conservation

Several reports of the Cuddy Group tipping illegally including barrels of chemical waste.

The land was tested and found to be contaminated in 2008 with Category 2 ,human health contamination including grade 1 classified carcinogens Arsenic & Benzo[a]pyrene. A remediation strategy was suggested but there is no evidence of remediation

The tunneling of the stream will create a bowl like effect and possible flooding of several houses in Glynneath

The loss of the stream and its related areas, woodland and hedgerows will have a negative effect on the biodiversity of the area, it goes agains the Local Biodiversity Action Plan, Local Development Plan and Environment Wales Act 2016 which identifies the stream as a Principal Habitat.
