Subject: The unnecessary death of Glynneath children
 Dear Glynneath Town Council,

This is a forwarded email from 19 March 2020 that includes the following paragraph and request of Councillor Haulwen Morgan, it references a meeting I had with Simon Knoyle in his role as a Glynneath Town Councillor in July 2019.

"I supplied Simon Knoyle with information last July that the Welsh Government have a policy that could result in children dying while in school, care facilities, sport facilities etc. I will copy you to an email exchange or two between myself and Simon. I would like you please to raise the question in the Glynneath Town Council about what happened to the information I provided Simon. I will also copy Simon to this email so he is aware that I am asking you this, he hasn't replied to my last email." (please scroll down to see the complete email).

the paragraph included the following request of Councillor H Morgan in her role as a Glynneath Town Councillor:

"I would like you please to raise the question in the Glynneath Town Council about what happened to the information I provided Simon."

The attached document provides evidence that the Welsh Government's play policies are based upon a scientific misrepresentation which may result in the unnecessary death of Glynneath children. We are aware that Simon Knoyle eventually forwarded the attached document to the Neath Port Talbot Council in his role as a county councillor, however I can find no evidence that this information has been acted upon in his role as Glynneath Town Councillor. According to the Glynneath Town Council website, the role of the Glynneath Town Council is separate to that of the Neath Port Talbot Council

The purpose of this email is to request whether or not this request was actioned, that the Glynneath Town Council ascertain what the Glynneath Town Councillor Simon Knoyle did with the information in his role as a Glynneath Town Councillor. I am unable to find a record of anything happening.

If nothing was done, could the Glynneath Town Council please include reference to the information about 'deep play' provided to Glynneath Town Council in their next FULL MEETING. Please keep the information OPEN and not create a sub-committee to discuss it, the. The information and actions relating to it could save the lives of not only Glynneath children but Welsh children in general.

Hi Heulwen - hope you are OK - I've copied you to an email to the council to request a delay on the planning for the Enzo development. I'm not against the development in general its just that in its current format I can envisage several potential problems.

1 - FLOOD RISK the inland flood plain / swamp area behind our house is going to be filled in and raised to a height of 4 metres with three houses built above the plain.

2 - LAND CONTAMINATION the land contamination testing has only been done to 0.5 metres in most places, it is an extremely shoddy attempt at testing for poisons etc. We know that Cuddy was dumping in the middle of the night and digging holes, dumping to at least 4 metres and covering up the material dumped, both actions raise alarm bells. No-one knows what is under the top layer soil.

Two of my children are chemists and they believe more specific testing should be done. Victoria is the chief editor of a chemistry journal

and Simon who is looking into it at present is just finishing his PhD in chemistry.

3. ENVIRONMENT - The planning application shows battery housing - they are putting houses everywhere they can without due regard to the environment - I believe there should be a green belt between Woodland Park / Brynhyfryd us and the development retaining the natural stream and tree belt so that excess water flowing off the site can flow into the stream and not into W Park and Brfhyd.
