Dear Councillor Edwards,

Thank you for your email. I would suggest that you clearly lack understanding of the situation on which you have commented. Your former clerk is hounding me for the information I am holding that relate to her actions as an employee of your council.

My email was to identify whether or not the Glynneath Town Council agreed with me or her on her definition of 'personal information'. In my reply to her which I supplied to the Glynneath Town Council for factual correctness, I included information about the cover up of Welsh government child abuse by the Glynneath Town Council and also the Glynneath Town Council compliance with the corporate manslaughter of Glynneath residents by the combined actions of unscrupulous developers and the NPTCBC planning department.

I believe that you should take the time out to read the document that you were supplied with and keep reading it until you understand it because it points to evidence of Plaid Cymru child abuse of which you are probably familiar, and the potential Corporate Manslaughter of Glynneath Residents by yourself and the other members of the Glynneath Town Council.

I would suggest that you are not paid by NPTCBC to offer sympathy to former employees and other councillors who are hiding information that has almost certainly caused the death of Glynneath residents. I would suggest that you are paid to represent the people who have elected you. Therefore, I would expect you to fully understand the complex issues at stake here before making snap factually incorrect judgements like the one you have made in your email.

I'm happy to enter into a dialogue with your self or anyone else openly or privately should you wish to in relation to the subjects covered in the documents supplied to GTC.

As a county councillor who is elected to support a community I believe you should take a leaf out of the book of Councillor Stephen K Hunt of Seven Sisters who has understood the problems we are facing with planning department corruption and has recently supported the people of East Glynneath by asking questions on our behalf in his role as chairman of the scrutiny committee for contaminated land. It should be noted that since he has asked these questions in a specific meeting relating to the development in which the head of planning refused to answer questions, the planning development manager Steve Ball offered his resignation. A sign that he was invited to leave before being pushed.

As a serving county councillor you will be aware of the role of the scrutiny committees and their importance in maintaining the integrity of the council workforce. For the head of a department to refuse to answer questions to the chair of a scrutiny committee, surely there has to be red flags flying at full mast and you as a serving member of the NPTCBC and the Glynneath Town Council should be asking questions like 'why'.

Dear Glynneath Town Council

Please can you discuss in a full Glynneath Town Council meeting, this contradictory statement by Councillor Knoyle in his role as a Neath-Port Talbot and Glynneath Town Councillor. The statement together with relevant information from the NPTC website can be seen in the attached image.

In a letter to the residents of this area, Councillor Knoyle infers that there are no plans in place for the Heol y Glyn development, while a search on the NPTC planning applications website reveals the planning application P2021/0546 for the site is awaiting a decision. This means there are plans in place and they could be approved at any time. It is important to understand that when this application is approved that at least 21,000 cubic metres of toxic waste will be moved around the site at will by the developer following the recent approval P2020/0863 which councillor Knoyle has supported that removed the requirement for testing of the spoil heap on the site..The movement of this contaminated soil will potentially poison the people of Glynneath, not just those surrounding the site but all of Glynneath may be affected by poisonous chemicals should an easterly wind blow while the developer is at work moving the contaminants around the site.

Please could you also urge Councillors Knoyle and Morgan to reply to our 10/9/2021 communication and provide a 'HUMAN HEALTH RISK ASSESSMENT' for the site as required by the most recent edition of the Council

Contaminated Land Strategy. The land has been chemically tested and has been found to be contaminated. As such a HUMAN HEALTH RISK ASSESSMENT should be made available to show how dangerous the contamination is to human health. Letters were delivered to the councillors homes requesting this, further info can be found in this YouTube video.
