Apologies for the rather blunt and distressing subject matter. I live in Glynneath close to where Ruth lived for several years and was friendly with Ruth's husband John. Ruth and John lived next to a toxic waste dump and the local council have hidden this information for at least the last 14 years. Two people living approximately 100 metres away from where Ruth and John lived have died of an extremely rare neuro-degenerative disorder Progressive Supra Nuclear Palsy which can be linked to toxic waste.
